BIG IDEA

Just like the Pharisees that Jesus was talking to, people in our churches today are one way on the outside and different on the outside.

KEY VERSES

Matthew 23:25-26

MEMORY VERSE

Matthew 23:25-26

"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. 26 Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean."

• PREPARATION & MATERIALS •

BIBLE LESSON

- Cast: Todd, Danny, Amos, Pastor, Sunday School Teacher, Jesus
- Props: Two large paper grocery bags with the words "Good Little Saved Kid" written on front. Cut out hole for the mouth.

GAME

• Tape or rope to mark the outline of 3 boats

CRAFT

- Soda tabs (three per child)
- Colored cord or ribbon (30 inches per child)
- Key chain ring (one per child)
- Metal crimps (one per child optional)

Needle nose pliers or jewelry crimper tool

[Tips: Todd and Danny center stage Amos enters and greets them. Each boy has a bag.

Todd: Hey guys!

Amos: What's going on?

Todd: We're going to try to find a girlfriend for Danny Boy here. (all laugh except for Danny)

Todd: Hello sir, we are doing great!

Amos: Couldn't be better.

Pastor: Well thank you boys. It does my heart good to see ya'll in church every Sunday. You

All: Thank you sir.

Pastor: Well, I need to be going. See you next Sunday. God bless.

All: You too, Good-bye. (pastor leaves and boys take off bags)

Todd: Man that was a close one

Danny: I know, I was afraid he was going to ask something about his message on Sunday. I

slept all the way through it.

Todd: Me too. Best nap I've had in a while. (all laugh)

Todd: Hey Amos, you alright?

Amos: I'm fine.

Danny: You guys ready to go? This place ain't cool. (Todd and Danny both slap hands)

Todd: Man what is this? Here comes our Sunday School teacher.

Danny: We must be standing to close to the church or something (boys put back on their

bags)

Teacher: Hello gentlemen. What are you up to?

Danny: Just standing around and talking.

Teacher: That's nice. Have you boys been able to do your quiet time every morning this week

like we were talking about last Sunday? (all three look away and pause.)

Teacher: Well?

All: (all three give positive answer) Yes. Sure have. You bet.

Teacher: That's good. Keep up the good work, I'll see you next Sunday.

All: Bye (teacher walks of and they take off the bags)

BIBLE LESSON . SKIT (CONT.)

Todd: Man, what is up with this? Let's go somewhere where we won't run into anymore people from church.

Danny: Too late. Look...it's Him. It's Jesus. (all three get their bags back on as Jesus enters)

Jesus: Amos, Todd, Danny, look at me. (Todd and Danny hold bags on tighter. Amos slowly takes off his bags and falls to his knees in front of Jesus)

Amos: Oh Lord, I'm tired of this game. I want to have the happiness that comes from you. I'm so covered with sin. Please forgive me. Save me...

Jesus: I have already saved you and I have always loved you. Take my hand and I will show you the way to live. I will never leave you.

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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What did the paper bags represent?
- What are some ways that people pretend to be good and righteous?
- Can we fool other people?
- · Can we fool ourselves?
- Can we fool Jesus?

SIMPLIFIED LESSON OPTIONS

- Show kids several items that are clean on the outside and dirty on the inside. See if they can figure out what is similar about the items.
- Discuss how people can be clean on the outside and dirty on the inside.
- Describe the Pharisees and how Jesus confronted them.
- Tell how Jesus can make us all clean on the inside.
- Ask 2-3 of the simpler discussion questions.

CRAFT & GAME

• CRAFT •

OBJECTIVE: SODA TAB KEYCHAIN

Kids will make sturdy key chains out of recycled soda tabs.

DIRECTIONS

- Cut three pieces of cord/ribbon 10 inches each
- · Fold in half
- Thread cord through the ring so it lays in the fold
- · Lay three soda tabs in a row beneath the key ring
- · Weave the odd pieces over, under, over under, over, under
- · Weave the even pieces under, over, under, over, under, over
- · Hold ends together with a knot or a crimp

MATERIALS PROVIDED BY EM

• Scissors, hole punches, staplers

MATERIALS BROUGHT BY TEAM

- Soda tabs (three per child)
- Colored cord or ribbon (30 inches per child)
- Key chain ring (one per child)
- Metal crimps (one per child optional)
- Needle nose pliers or jewelry crimper tool

SIMPLIFIED CRAFT OPTIONS

- · Braid thick yarn on the key ring
- · String beads on the key ring

• GAME

OBJECTIVE: BOAT TAG

Listen carefully and run to a new boat before you get tagged.

MATERIALS BROUGHT BY TEAM

• Tape or rope to mark the outline of 3 boats

INSTRUCTIONS

- Choose one person to be "it". Separate the remaining players into 3 groups. Each group stands in a separate boat marked on the floor.
- One at a a time call out descriptions such as "kids wearing red" or "2nd graders". Kids who fit the description try to run to a new boat without being tagged. Periodically call "shipwreck" and everyone must run to a new boat.
- If someone is tagged they become "it".
