• PREPARATION & MATERIALS •

BIBLE LESSON

Flashlight, dirty pieces of cloth, clean pieces of cloth, dirty socks, clean socks, dirty paper, clean paper, batteries that work in the flashlight, bucket.

GAME

- Photocopies of Coloring Sheet (1 per child)

CRAFT: GLOW STICK TUBES

- Cardboard tubes (from toilet paper), 1 per child
- Glow sticks, several per child

BIBLE LESSON

Lesson 2

Preparation: Remove batteries from flashlight and fill it with dirty cloths and socks. Put the clean socks and batteries in the bucket nearby.

Does anybody know what God compares his children to? (Accept various answers until someone says "light")

God says we are the light of the world and he wants us to shine. What does it mean to shine in this world? (Accept a few answers)

Sometimes though we can't shine very brightly or maybe not at all. Like this flashlight here. I haven't been able to make it shine today. (Demonstrate turning in on and off)

Can anybody help me make it shine? (Allow kids to try it. It's OK if a child opens the flashlight and discovers the dirty things. If they don't discover the dirty things, do it yourself)

Oh my goodness, look at these dirty things. The flashlight is full of them. No wonder the light isn't working. These dirty things are like sin, they make our hearts dirty and we can't shine God's love. Maybe we are being very selfish, or holding on to anger against someone. Maybe we have been telling a lies or cheating on school work. Maybe we have mean thoughts about a friend.

Sometimes people try to stop sinning and live a perfect looking life all by themselves. It would be like washing out the rags and making them clean. Pretend to was the dirty rags in the bucket and take out the clean ones. Fill the flashlight back up with clean rags)

There all clean. No more sin. Now the light can shine brightly! Right? (Try it. Let the kids try it.)

Why isn't it working? Right, because it's still full of rags and paper, even if they are clean. They don't have any power. We can't shine God's love without God's help. At best all we can show is clean looking things.

If we really want to change and shine God's light in this world then we need real power. We need God to forgive our sins (open the flashlight and take out all the rags) and fill us with his Holy Spirit (put in batteries). That is the only way we can shine brightly in this world (turn on the flash light).

LA LINTERNA COMPLETA

LECCIÓN DE LA BIBLIA



Gran idea: Cuando nuestras vidas están llenas de pecado sucio no somos capaces de brillar la verdad y el amor de Dios a los que nos rodean. Incluso si limpiamos nuestras vidas y tratar de no pecar, todavía no podemos cantar la verdad de Dios y el amor. Sólo por el perdón de Dios y el Espíritu Santo podemos brillar.

Verso de la biblia: "Deja que tu luz brille ante los hombres, para que vean sus buenas obras y glorifiquen a tu Padre que está en el cielo" Mateo 05:16 b

Accesorios: la linterna, pedazos sucios de tela, pedazos de tela limpia, calcetines sucios, calcetines limpios, papel sucio, papel limpio, las baterías que funcionan en la linterna.

Preparación: Saque las pilas de la linterna y lo rellenos con trapos sucios y los calcetines. Poner los calcetines y las baterías limpias en el cubo cerca.

¿Alguien sabe lo que Dios compara sus hijos? (Aceptar varias respuestas hasta que alguien dice "luz")

Dios dice que somos la luz del mundo, y él quiere que nosotros brillamos. ¿Qué significa brillar en este mundo? (Acepte algunas respuestas)

A veces, aunque no podemos brillar mucho o tal vez no brillas nada. ¿Te gusta esta linterna aquí. No he sido capaz de brillar hoy. (Demostrar inflexión en encendido y apagado)

¿Puede alguien ayudarme a brillar? (Permita que los niños lo prueben. Está bien si un niño abre la linterna y descubre las cosas sucias. Si no descubren las cosas sucias, hágalo usted mismo)

¡Oh Dios mío, mira estas cosas sucias. La linterna está llena de ellos. No es extraño que la luz no funciona. Estas cosas sucias son como el pecado, que hacen que nuestros corazones sucios y no podemos brillar del amor de Dios. Tal vez estamos siendo muy egoísta, o estamos enojados con alguien. Tal vez hemos estado diciendo una mentira o engañando a en el trabajo escolar. Tal vez tenemos pensamientos acerca de un amigo.

A veces las personas tratan de dejar de pecar y vivir una vida perfecta por sí mismos. Sería como lavar los trapos y haciéndolos limpios. Fingir que fueron los trapos sucios en el cubo y sacar los limpios. Llene la linterna de nuevo con trapos limpios)

Hay todo limpio. No más pecado. Ahora la luz puede brillar! ¿Cierto? (Prueba. Deje que los niños prueben.)

¿Por qué no está funcionando? Claro, porque es todavía lleno de trapos y papel, incluso si están limpias. Ellos no tienen ningún poder. No podemos brillar del amor de Dios sin la ayuda de Dios. En el mejor de todo lo que podemos mostrar es cosas limpias.

Si realmente queremos cambiar y hacer brillar la luz de Dios en este mundo, entonces necesitamos el poder real. Necesitamos que Dios perdone nuestros pecados (abrir la linterna y sacar todos los trapos) y nos llene de su Espíritu Santo (poner en baterías). Esa es la única manera en que podemos brillar en este mundo (encender la luz del flash).

• CRAFT •

OBJECTIVE: GLOWSTICK TUBES

Cut holes in a cardboard tube, add a glow stick, and let the light shine through!

MATERIALS PROVIDED BY EM

- Scissors, staplers, hole punches

EXAMPLE



This example uses tall 5 x 1/2 inch glow sticks. The flexible thin glow sticks will also work.

MATERIALS BROUGHT BY TEAM

- Cardboard tubes (from toilet paper), 1 per child
- Glow sticks, several per child
- Decorations such as stickers, markers, glitter glue
- Tape
- String

DIRECTIONS

- Cut small shapes out of the tube such as circles, triangles, crescents, etc.
- Use hole punch to create small holes (optional)
- Decorate outside of tube with stickers, markers, glitter glue, etc.
- Place a glow stick inside
- Seal the top and bottom of the tube with tape
- Tape a loop of string to one end of the tube so that it can be hung on a wall or swung in circles

Note: Glow sticks have limited glow time. You might instruct the kids to break the stick (to start the glow) in the evening when it is dark. If possible send a few spare glow sticks home with each child.

SIMPLIFIED CRAFT OPTIONS

- *Precut holes in tubes*
- *Use hole punches to put small holes in tubes*

• GAME •

OBJECTIVE: CHANGES

Kids make a change in appearance. Kids try to guess what change was made.

MATERIALS BROUGHT BY TEAM

- none

INSTRUCTIONS

Everyone sits in a circle. One player is sent out of the room. Now a change will be made in the circle.

Example: 2 players exchange jackets or places, or 1 player changes his T-shirt so he is wearing it backwards. The player who was out of the room comes in and must guess the changes made to the circle. Make sure changes are big and somewhat obvious.



GAME OPTIONS

- Divide a large group into several smaller groups
- Add an active game after such as tag or a relay race after playing this game
